Final papers should have a maximum length limit of **9 (nine) printed pages**, including all the figures, references, and appendices. 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Each paper must be presented by an author of the paper in person at the conference. Presentations via teleconference (e.g., Skype) or pre-recorded tape are not permitted. Permission to have the paper presented by a substitute presenter may be granted by the TPC Chairs under certain extraordinary circumstances. Authors with travel contingencies should consider arranging a substitute presenter. A substitute presenter must be qualified to answer questions regarding the paper. A request of a substitute presenter must be sent to the TPC Chairs no later than 5:00 pm US EDT, Monday, April 20th, 2015. The TPC Chairs may approve or deny the request by 5:00 pm US EDT Friday, April 24th, 2015. No response by the TPC Chairs is considered a denial.

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
